SUBCOMMITTEE ON COMMUNICATIONS AND TECHNOLOGY  
HYBRID MARKUP

WEDNESDAY, JUNE 15, 2022

The Subcommittee on Communications and Technology of the Committee on Energy and Commerce met, pursuant to notice, at 10:20 a.m., a quorum being present, for a hybrid markup in the John D. Dingell Room, 2123 of the Rayburn House Office Building and on the Committee's Webex platform, Hon. Mike Doyle (Chairman of the subcommittee) presiding. The business before the Subcommittee was consideration and markup of six bills. The following actions were taken:

1. [H.R. 4275](#), the "Ensuring Phone and Internet Access for SNAP Recipients Act of 2021," was ordered reported favorably to the full Committee, **amended**, by a voice vote (**Final Passage**).

The following amendment was offered during consideration of H.R. 4275:

- **An Amendment in the nature of a substitute (AINS) #1** ([H4275 ANS 01](#)), offered by Mr. Pallone, was agreed to by a voice vote.

2. [H.R. 4990](#), the "Institute for Telecommunication Sciences Codification Act" or the "ITS Codification Act," was ordered reported favorably to the full Committee, **amended**, by a roll call vote of 27 yeas to 0 nays ([CAT Roll Call No. 1](#)) (**Final Passage**).

The following amendment was offered during consideration of H.R. 4990:

- **An Amendment in the nature of a substitute (AINS) #1** ([OHALLE 224](#)), offered by Mr. O'Halleran, was agreed to by a voice vote.

3. [H.R. 5400](#), the "Preventing Disruptions to Universal Service Funds Act," was ordered reported favorably to the full Committee, **amended**, by a roll call vote of 29 yeas to 0 nays ([CAT Roll Call No. 2](#)) (**Final Passage**).

The following amendment was offered during consideration of H.R. 5400:

- **An Amendment in the nature of a substitute (AINS) #1** ([H5400 ANS 01](#)), offered by Mr. Curtis, was agreed to by a voice vote.

4. [H.R. 5486](#), the "Simplifying Management, Reallocation, and Transfer of Spectrum Act" or the "SMART Act," was ordered reported favorably to the full Committee, **amended**, by a voice vote. (**Final Passage**).

The following amendment was offered during consideration of H.R. 5486:

5. [H.R. 7132](#), the “Safe Connections Act of 2022,” was ordered reported favorably to the full Committee, **amended**, by a roll call vote of 29 yeas to 0 nays ([CAT Roll Call No. 3](#)) (**Final Passage**).

The following amendment was offered during consideration of H.R. 7132:

- **An Amendment in the nature of a substitute (AINS) #1** ([H7132 ANS 01](#)), offered by Mr. Walberg, was agreed to by a voice vote.
6. [H.R. 7624](#), the “Spectrum Innovation Act of 2022,” was ordered reported favorably to the full Committee, **amended**, by a roll call vote of 29 yeas to 0 nays ([CAT Roll Call No. 4](#)) (**Final Passage**).

The following amendment was offered during consideration of H.R. 7624:

- **An Amendment in the nature of a substitute (AINS) #1** ([H7624 ANS 02](#)), offered by Mr. Latta, was agreed to by a voice vote.
7. [H.R. 7783](#), the “Extending America’s Spectrum Auction Leadership Act of 2022,” was ordered reported favorably to the full Committee, without **amendment**, by a roll call vote of 29 yeas to 0 nays ([CAT Roll Call No. 5](#)) (**Final Passage**).

No amendments were offered during consideration of H.R. 7783.
