# A BILL

To direct the Assistant Secretary of Commerce for Communications and Information to publish data from the Broadband Equity, Access, and Deployment Program, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PUBLICATION OF DATA FROM BROADBAND EQ-**  
4 **UITY, ACCESS, AND DEPLOYMENT PROGRAM.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 1 year after the  
6 date of the enactment of this Act, and annually thereafter  
7 until all amounts made available for the Program have

1 been obligated by the Assistant Secretary, and notwith-  
2 standing any other provision of law, the Assistant Sec-  
3 retary shall make publicly available on the website of the  
4 National Telecommunications and Information Adminis-  
5 tration the data collected from grant recipients and sub-  
6 grantees under the Program that is related to the diver-  
7 sity, equity, inclusion, and accessibility elements of the  
8 Program, including data relating to—

9 (1) subgrantee ownership demographics and the  
10 demographics of the workforce used for activities as-  
11 sisted with Program funding; and

12 (2) the number and amount of contracts and  
13 subcontracts awarded under the Program to minor-  
14 ity business enterprises and to women's business en-  
15 terprises.

16 (b) ACCESSIBILITY.—The data made publicly avail-  
17 able under subsection (a) shall be—

18 (1) made available as an open Government data  
19 asset (as defined in section 3502 of title 44, United  
20 States Code);

21 (2) freely available for download in bulk;

22 (3) rendered in a human-readable format; and

23 (4) accessible via application programming  
24 interface where appropriate.

1 **SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.**

2 In this Act:

3 (1) ASSISTANT SECRETARY.—The term “Assist-  
4 ant Secretary” means the Assistant Secretary of  
5 Commerce for Communications and Information.

6 (2) PROGRAM.—The term “Program” means  
7 the Broadband Equity, Access, and Deployment Pro-  
8 gram established under section 60102(b)(1) of the  
9 Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (47 U.S.C.  
10 1702(b)(1)).
