BILL: Discussion Draft, the “FTC Process and Transparency Reform Act of 2016”

AMENDMENT: An amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute offered by Ms. Schakowsky, No. 1c, to provide that the Commission shall have no authority under section 5 or section 18 of the Federal Trade Commission Act to declare unlawful an act or practice on the grounds that such act or practice is unfair unless the act or practice causes or is likely to cause substantial injury to consumers which is not reasonably avoidable by consumers themselves and not outweighed by countervailing benefits to consumers or to competition, unless the act or practice relates to data security or privacy, including a case in which an internet connected camera or other device with camera capability is used to monitor children or a user of the camera or device without the knowledge of the user.

DISPOSITION: NOT AGREED TO, by a roll call vote of 8 yeas and 12 nays.
