**SUBCOMMITTEE ON CONSUMER PROTECTION AND COMMERCE
MARKUP**

WEDNESDAY, JULY 10, 2019

The Subcommittee on Consumer Protection and Commerce met in open markup session at 10 a.m. in the John D. Dingell Room, 2123 of the Rayburn House Office Building, the Hon. Jan Schakowsky (*chairwoman*) presiding. The markup was convened at 10:03 a.m., pursuant to notice, for consideration of six bills.

- (1) **H.R. 2211**, the “Stop Tip-over of Unstable, Risky Dressers on Youth Act” or the “STURDY Act” (*Reps. Schakowsky, McNerney, Soto, and Rush*), was favorably forwarded to the full Committee, amended, by a voice vote.

The following amendment was offered:

An amendment in the nature of a substitute by Ms. Schakowsky, # 1, was adopted by a voice vote.

- (2) **H.R. 3172**, the “Safe Sleep for Babies Act of 2019” (*Rep. Cárdenas*), was favorably forwarded to the full Committee, amended, by a voice vote.

The following amendment was offered:

An amendment by Mr. Pallone on behalf of Mr. Cárdenas, # 1, was adopted by a voice vote.

- (3) **H.R. 3170**, the “Safe Crib Act of 2019” (*Reps. Schakowsky, Kelly of Illinois, and Rush*), was favorably forwarded to the full Committee, amended, by a voice vote.

The following amendment was offered:

An amendment by Ms. Rodgers, # 1, was adopted by a voice vote.

- (4) **H.R.1618**, the “Nicolas and Zachary Burt Carbon Monoxide Poisoning Prevention Act of 2019” (*Reps. Kuster of New Hampshire and Carter of Georgia*), was favorably forwarded to the full Committee, amended, by a voice vote.

The following amendment was offered:

An amendment in the nature of a substitute by Ms. Schakowsky, # 1, was adopted by a voice vote.

- (5) **H.R. 806**, the “Portable Fuel Container Safety Act of 2019” (*Reps. Thompson of California and others*), was favorably forwarded to the full Committee, amended, by a voice vote.

The following amendments were offered:

An amendment in the nature of a substitute by Mr. Latta, # 1, was adopted by a voice vote.

- (6) **H.R. 2647**, the “Safer Occupancy Furniture Flammability Act” or “SOFFAA” (*Reps. Matsui, Griffith, Rush, and Cárdenas*), was favorably forwarded to the full Committee, without amendment, by a voice vote.

No amendments were offered.
