Traner Jr High School, Reno, NV: lost election for Student Body President by one vote.

Sparks High School (Nevada) Class of 1967, Junior Class and Student Body President

University of Nevada, Reno graduated 1973 with Bachelor of Science while in medical school in second inaugural class.

Served 2 year mission in France 1968-1970. Saw from the road the nuclear fuel reprocessing plant just outside of Cherbourg, France where I was serving.

Joined the United States Air Force with the HPSP (Health Professions Scholarship Program) with intermittent periods of active duty during medical school. Reserve status during Family Practice Residency (1976-1979) in Phoenix, Arizona which now has a nuclear power plant.

Graduated with M.D. from Washington University, St Louis, Missouri June 1976. Near Scott AFB in Illinois.

Active Duty as family physician at Ellsworth AFB, Rapid City, South Dakota 1979-1982. Strategic Air Command with both bombers and missiles in the Cold War. Separated with rank of Major.

Moved to Southern Nevada, home of the Nevada Test Site with above ground and below ground uncontained nuclear tests. Friends with people commonly called "Downwinders".

Active in community and church affairs, currently Sunday School teacher and Nevada State Senator District #12 (Clark County in parts of Henderson and Moapa Valley, and all of Mesquite, Bunkerville, Searchlight, Boulder City and Laughlin and rural spaces in between). All areas that would be concerned about the transportation of nuclear waste.

Former President of Nevada Academy of Family Physicians and Collegium Aesculapium (international physicians group, faith based). Former City Councilman Boulder City, Nevada and State Assemblyman 1999-2002. Current Nevada State Senator 2002-term expires 2018 (not yet term limited till after next election 2018). Current President Pro Tempore State Senate.

Family physician in Southern Nevada since 1982. Currently Associate Professor Touro University of Nevada, College of Osteopathic Medicine since 11/1/2012. Licensed in UT, AZ, NV.
