To amend the Safe Drinking Water Act to require the Administrator of the Environmental Protection Agency to publish a maximum contaminant level goal and promulgate a national primary drinking water regulation for total per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances, and for other purposes.

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Protect Drinking
5 Water from PFAS Act of 2019”.

1 **SEC. 2. DEADLINE FOR REGULATIONS ON PFAS.**

2 Section 1412(b)(12) of the Safe Drinking Water Act
3 (42 U.S.C. 300g-1(b)(12)) is amended by adding at the
4 end the following:

5 “(C) PER- AND POLYFLUOROALKYL SUB-
6 STANCES.—Notwithstanding any other deadline
7 established in this subsection, not later than 2
8 years after the date of enactment of this sub-
9 paragraph, the Administrator shall publish a
10 maximum contaminant level goal and promul-
11 gate a national primary drinking water regula-
12 tion for total per- and polyfluoroalkyl sub-
13 stances.”.

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
