SUBJECT: Subcommittee Hearing on “The CLEAN Future Act and Drinking Water: Legislation to Ensure Drinking Water is Safe and Clean”

The Subcommittee on Environment and Climate Change of the Committee on Energy and Commerce will hold a virtual, fully remote hearing on **Tuesday, May 25, 2021, at 11:30 a.m. (EDT)**. The hearing is entitled, “The CLEAN Future Act and Drinking Water: Legislation to Ensure Drinking Water is Safe and Clean.” Witnesses will be by invitation only.
