Subject: Full Committee Markup

On **Wednesday, March 20, 2013, at 10:00 a.m. in 1324 Longworth House Office Building**, the Committee on Natural Resources will hold a markup on the following bills:

- **H.R. 527**, To amend the Helium Act to complete the privatization of the Federal helium reserve in a competitive market fashion that ensures stability in the helium markets while protecting the interests of American taxpayers, and for other purposes. “Responsible Helium Administration and Stewardship Act”

Note that Members should draft amendments to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 527, which will be made available on the committee website at <http://naturalresources.house.gov/>.

- **H.R. 254**, To authorize the Secretary of the Interior to facilitate the development of hydroelectric power on the Diamond Fork System of the Central Utah Project. “Bonneville Unit Clean Hydropower Facilitation Act”
- **H.R. 291**, To provide for the conveyance of certain cemeteries that are located on National Forest System land in Black Hills National Forest, South Dakota. “Black Hills Cemetery Act”
- **H.R. 507**, To provide for the conveyance of certain land inholdings owned by the United States to the Pascua Yaqui Tribe of Arizona, and for other purposes. “Pascua Yaqui Tribe Trust Land Act”
- **H.R. 588**, To provide for donor contribution acknowledgments to be displayed at the Vietnam Veterans Memorial Visitor Center, and for other purposes. “Vietnam Veterans Donor Acknowledgment Act of 2013”

- **H.R. 678**, To authorize all Bureau of Reclamation conduit facilities for hydropower development under Federal Reclamation law, and for other purposes. “Bureau of Reclamation Small Conduit Hydropower Development and Rural Jobs Act”
- **H.R. 716**, To direct the Secretary of the Interior to convey certain Federal land to the city of Vancouver, Washington, and for other purposes.
- **H.R. 1033**, To authorize the acquisition and protection of nationally significant battlefields and associated sites of the Revolutionary War and the War of 1812 under the American Battlefield Protection Program. “American Battlefield Protection Program Amendments Act of 2013”
- **H.R. 1159**, To modify the Forest Service Recreation Residence Program by implementing a simple, equitable, and predictable procedure for determining cabin user fees, and for other purposes. “Cabin Fee Act of 2013”
