## A BILL

To prohibit an increase in the lands administered by the Bureau of Land Management until a centralized database of all lands identified as suitable for disposal by Resource Management Plans for lands under the administrative jurisdiction of the Bureau is easily accessible to the public on a website of the Bureau.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON ACQUISITION OF LAND.**

4       (a) **SHORT TITLE.**—This Act may be cited as the  
5       “Land Disposal Transparency and Efficiency Act”.

1           (b) PROHIBITION ON ACQUISITION OF LAND.—No  
2 land or interests in land may be added by acquisition, do-  
3 nation, transfer of administrative jurisdiction, or other-  
4 wise to the inventory of land and interests in land adminis-  
5 tered by the Bureau of Land Management until a central-  
6 ized database of all lands identified as suitable for disposal  
7 by Resource Management Plans for lands under the ad-  
8 ministrative jurisdiction of the Bureau is easily accessible  
9 to the public on a website of the Bureau.
