Terry Flores is the Executive Director of Northwest RiverPartners, a broad based non-profit formed in 2005 as a result of ongoing litigation over northwest federal hydro system operations on the Columbia and Snake rivers. RiverPartners has over 100 members including northwest electric utilities, agricultural organizations, ports and businesses.

RiverPartners promotes the environmental and economic benefits of the Columbia and Snake River dams which provide carbon-free, reliable electricity for homes and businesses, irrigation, flood control, recreation, and a river highway that helps fuel the Northwest's economy. The organization supports fish and protection and restoration policies and actions based in sound science and cost effectiveness. RiverPartners advocates for hydro on behalf of its members in the courts, in the media, with decision makers, and through its Clean Hydro public education campaign.

Previously, Ms. Flores was Hydroelectric Licensing Director for PacifiCorp, responsible for overseeing licensing activities for the company's hydro portfolio. She has a Bachelor of Science degree in Ecosystems Management from Huxley College of Environmental Studies and a degree in Biology from Western Washington University.
