

Committee on Natural Resources – Markup Action

The Committee on Natural Resources met on Wednesday, July 17, 2019, and considered the following bills:

H.R. 1373, “*Grand Canyon Centennial Protection Act.*”

Subcommittee on National Parks, Forests, and Public Lands was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 1373 by unanimous consent.

- An amendment offered by Mr. Gosar #1 to the Grijalva amendment in the nature of a substitute was not agreed to by a roll call vote of 14 yeas and 20 nays.
- An amendment offered by Mr. Gosar #2 to the Grijalva amendment in the nature of a substitute was not agreed to by a roll call vote of 14 yeas and 20 nays.
- An amendment offered by Mr. Gosar #3 to the Grijalva amendment in the nature of a substitute was not agreed to by a roll call vote of 14 yeas and 20 nays.
- An amendment offered by Ms. Cheney #4 to the Grijalva amendment in the nature of a substitute was not agreed to by a roll call vote of 15 yeas and 19 nays.
- An amendment offered by Mr. Gosar #5 to the Grijalva amendment in the nature of a substitute was not agreed to by a roll call vote of 14 yeas and 20 nays.
- An amendment offered by Mr. Gosar #6 to the Grijalva amendment in the nature of a substitute was not agreed to by a roll call vote of 14 yeas and 20 nays.
- The Grijalva amendment in the nature of a substitute was agreed to by voice vote.
- H.R. 1373, as amended, was adopted and ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by a roll call vote of 21 yeas and 14 nays.

H.R. 2181, “*Chaco Cultural Heritage Area Protection Act of 2019.*”

Subcommittee on National Parks, Forests, and Public Lands and the Subcommittee on Energy and Mineral Resources were discharged from further consideration of H.R. 2181 by unanimous consent.

- An amendment offered by Mr. Gosar #3 was not agreed to by a roll call vote of 14 yeas and 19 nays.
- An amendment offered by Mr. Gosar #5 was not agreed to by a roll call vote of 14 yeas and 19 nays.
- An amendment offered by Mr. Lamborn #2 was not agreed to by a roll call vote of 14 yeas and 19 nays.
- H.R. 2181 was adopted and ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by a roll call vote of 19 yeas and 14 nays.

H.R. 3405, *“Removing Uranium from the Critical Minerals List Act.”*

Subcommittee on Energy and Mineral Resources was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 3405 by unanimous consent.

- The Grijalva amendment in the nature of a substitute was agreed to by voice vote.
- H.R. 3405, as amended, was adopted and ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by a roll call vote of 19 yeas and 15 nays.
