

**AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE
TO H.R. 3465
OFFERED BY MR. GRIJALVA OF ARIZONA**

Strike all after the enacting clause and insert the following new text:

1 SEC. 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the “Fallen Journalists Me-
3 morial Act”.

**4 SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION TO ESTABLISH COMMEMORATIVE
5 WORK.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Fallen Journalists Memorial
7 Foundation may establish a commemorative work on Fed-
8 eral land in the District of Columbia and its environs to
9 commemorate America’s global commitment to a free and
10 independent press by honoring journalists who sacrificed
11 their lives.

12 (b) COMPLIANCE WITH STANDARDS FOR COMMEMO-
13 RATIVE WORKS.—The establishment of the commemora-
14 tive work under this section shall be in accordance with
15 chapter 89 of title 40, United States Code (commonly
16 known as the “Commemorative Works Act”).

17 (c) PROHIBITION ON USE OF FEDERAL FUNDS.—

1 (1) IN GENERAL.—Federal funds may not be
2 used to pay any expense of the establishment of the
3 commemorative work under this section.

4 (2) RESPONSIBILITY OF THE FALLEN JOURNAL-
5 ISTS MEMORIAL FOUNDATION.—The Fallen Journal-
6 ists Memorial Foundation shall be solely responsible
7 for acceptance of contributions for, and payment of
8 the expenses of, the establishment of the commemo-
9 rative work under this section.

10 (d) DEPOSIT OF EXCESS FUNDS.—

11 (1) IN GENERAL.—If upon payment of all ex-
12 penses for the establishment of the memorial (in-
13 cluding the maintenance and preservation amount
14 required by section 8906(b)(1) of title 40, United
15 States Code), there remains a balance of funds re-
16 ceived for the establishment of the commemorative
17 work, the Fallen Journalists Memorial Foundation
18 shall transmit the amount of the balance to the Sec-
19 retary of the Interior for deposit in the account pro-
20 vided for in section 8906(b)(3) of title 40, United
21 States Code.

22 (2) ON EXPIRATION OF AUTHORITY.—If upon
23 expiration of the authority for the commemorative
24 work under section 8903(e) of title 40, United
25 States Code, there remains a balance of funds re-

1 ceived for the establishment of the commemorative
2 work, the Fallen Journalists Memorial Foundation
3 shall transmit the amount of the balance to a sepa-
4 rate account with the National Park Foundation for
5 memorials, to be available to the Secretary of the In-
6 terior or Administrator (as appropriate) following
7 the process provided in section 8906(b)(4) of title
8 40, United States Code, for accounts established
9 under section 8906(b)(2) or (3) of title 40, United
10 States Code.
