

## COMMITTEE ON NATURAL RESOURCES -- ACTION REPORT

The Committee on Natural Resources met in open session on Wednesday, July 26, 2023, to consider the following measures. Per Committee Rule 9(f) and House Rule XI, clause 2(e), amendments adopted will be posted within 24 hours, and roll call votes and all other amendments offered will be posted no later than 48 hours after the vote is taken. **H.R. 4141 (Rep. Fulcher)**, To provide that certain communications projects are not subject to requirements to prepare certain environmental or historical preservation reviews, and for other purposes.

The Subcommittee on Federal Lands was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 4141.

- Representative Russ Fulcher (R-ID) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute designated Fulcher ANS\_012.  
The amendment was agreed to by voice vote.
- Representative Raul Grijalva (D-AZ) offered an amendment designated Grijalva #1.  
The amendment was withdrawn via unanimous consent.

H.R. 4141, as amended, was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by a roll call vote of **22 to 13**.

**H.R. 3675 (Rep. Boebert)**, To amend the Water Infrastructure Improvements for the Nation Act to extend certain contract prepayment authority. “*Western Water Accelerated Revenue Repayment Act.*”

The Subcommittee on Water, Wildlife and Fisheries was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 3675.

- Representative Lauren Boebert (R-CO) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute designated Boebert ANS\_112.  
The amendment was agreed to by voice vote.

H.R. 3675, as amended, was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by a roll call vote of **22 to 14**.

**H.R. 2717 (Rep. Moore of Utah)**, To authorize the National Medal of Honor Museum Foundation to establish a commemorative work on the National Mall to honor the extraordinary acts of valor, selfless service, and sacrifice displayed by Medal of Honor recipients. “*Hershel “Woody” Williams National Medal of Honor Monument Location Act.*”

The Subcommittee on Federal Lands was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 2717.

- Representative Bruce Westerman (R-AR) offered an amendment designated Westerman\_037.

The amendment was agreed to by voice vote.

H.R. 2717, as amended, was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by a roll call vote of **29 to 0**.

**H.R. 3049 (Rep. Curtis)**, To provide for the exchange of certain Federal land and State land in the State of Utah. “*Utah School and Institutional Trust Lands Administration Exchange Act of 2023.*”

The Subcommittee on Federal Lands was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 3049.

H.R. 3049 was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by a roll call vote of **30 to 0**.

**H.R. 2997 (Rep. Boebert)**, To direct the Secretary of the Interior to convey to Mesa County, Colorado, certain Federal land in Colorado, and for other purposes. “*Clifton Opportunities Now for Vibrant Economic Yields (CONVEY) Act.*”

The Subcommittee on Federal Lands was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 2997.

- Representative Lauren Boebert (R-CO) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute designated Boebert ANS\_093.

The amendment was agreed to by voice vote.

H.R. 2997, as amended, was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by voice vote.

**H.R. 3499 (Rep. Issa)**, To amend title 5, United States Code, to provide direct hire authority to appoint individuals to Federal wildland firefighting and firefighting support positions in the Forest Service or the Department of the Interior, and for other purposes. “*Direct Hire To Fight Fires Act*”

The Subcommittee on Federal Lands was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 3499.

- Representative Bruce Westerman (R-AR) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute designated Westerman ANS #1.

The amendment was agreed to by voice vote.

H.R. 3499, as amended, was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by a roll call vote of **32 to 0**.

**H.R. 1318 (Rep. Neguse)**, To authorize the location of a monument on the National Mall to commemorate and honor the women’s suffrage movement and the passage of the 19th Amendment to the Constitution, and for other purposes. “*Women’s Suffrage National Monument Location Act.*”

The Subcommittee on Federal Lands was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 1318.

H.R. 1318 was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by a roll call vote of **32 to 0.**

**H.R. 4377 (Rep. Grijalva)**, To amend the Military Lands Withdrawal Act of 1999 with respect to extensions, additions, and revisions to the Barry M. Goldwater Range in Arizona.

The Subcommittee on Federal Lands was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 4377.

H.R. 4377 was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by a roll call vote of **32 to 0.**

**H.R. 1722 (Rep. Salinas)**, To amend the Grand Ronde Reservation Act, and for other purposes. “*Grand Ronde Reservation Act Amendment of 2023.*”

The Subcommittee on Indian and Insular Affairs was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 1722.

H.R. 1722 was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by a roll call vote of **32 to 0.**
