

**AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDMENT IN THE
NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO H.R. 8790
OFFERED BY MS. HOYLE OF OREGON**

Add at the end of subtitle B of title I the following
new sections:

**1 SEC. 115. JOINT CHIEFS LANDSCAPE RESTORATION PART-
2 NERSHIP PROGRAM.**

3 Section 40808 of the Infrastructure Investment and
4 Jobs Act (16 U.S.C. 6592d) is amended—

5 (1) in subsection (a)(2)—

6 (A) in subparagraph (B), by striking “or”
7 at the end;

8 (B) in subparagraph (C), by striking the
9 period at the end and inserting a semicolon;
10 and

11 (C) by adding at the end the following:

12 “(D) to recover from wildfires; or

13 “(E) to enhance soil, water, and related
14 natural resources.”;

15 (2) in subsection (d)(1)—

16 (A) in subparagraph (A), by inserting
17 “and post-wildfire impacts” after “wildfire
18 risk”; and

1 (B) in subparagraph (F), by inserting “,
2 as identified in the corresponding State forest
3 action plan or similar priority plan (such as a
4 State wildlife or water plan)” before the semi-
5 colon;

6 (3) in subsection (g)(2), by inserting “and at
7 least once every 2 fiscal years thereafter” after “and
8 2023”; and

9 (4) in subsection (h)(1), by striking “and
10 2023” each place it appears and inserting “through
11 2028”.

12 **SEC. 116. COLLABORATIVE FOREST LANDSCAPE RESTORA-**
13 **TION PROGRAM.**

14 Section 4003 of the Omnibus Public Land Manage-
15 ment Act of 2009 (16 U.S.C. 7303) is amended—

16 (1) in subsection (b)(3)—

17 (A) in subparagraph (D), by striking “spe-
18 cies;” and inserting “species or pathogens;”;

19 (B) in subparagraph (G), by striking
20 “and” at the end;

21 (C) in subparagraph (H), by adding “and”
22 after the semicolon at the end; and

23 (D) by adding at the end the following:

24 “(I) address standardized monitoring ques-
25 tions and indicators;”;

1 (2) in subsection (c)(3)(A)—

2 (A) in clause (i), by striking “and” at the
3 end;

4 (B) in clause (ii), by adding “and” at the
5 end; and

6 (C) by adding at the end the following:

7 “(iii) include a plan to provide sup-
8 port to collaborative processes established
9 pursuant to subsection (b)(2);”;

10 (3) in subsection (d)—

11 (A) in paragraph (2)—

12 (i) in subparagraph (E), by striking
13 “and” at the end;

14 (ii) in subparagraph (F), by striking
15 the period at the end and inserting “;
16 and”; and

17 (iii) by adding at the end the fol-
18 lowing:

19 “(G) proposals that seek to use innovative
20 implementation mechanisms, including good
21 neighbor agreements entered into under section
22 8206 of the Agricultural Act of 2014 (16
23 U.S.C. 2113a);

1 “(H) proposals that seek to reduce the risk
2 of uncharacteristic wildfire or increase ecologi-
3 cal restoration activities—

4 “(i) within areas across land owner-
5 ships, including State, Tribal, and private
6 land; and

7 “(ii) within the wildland-urban inter-
8 face (as defined in section 101 of the
9 Healthy Forests Restoration Act of 2003
10 (16 U.S.C. 6511)); and

11 “(I) proposals that seek to enhance water-
12 shed health and drinking water sources.”; and
13 (B) in paragraph (3)—

14 (i) by amending subparagraph (A) to
15 read as follows:

16 “(A) 4 proposals in any 1 region of the
17 National Forest System to be funded during
18 any fiscal year; and”;

19 (ii) by striking subparagraph (B); and

20 (iii) by redesignating subparagraph
21 (C) as subparagraph (B); and

22 (4) in subsection (f)(6), by striking “2019
23 through 2023” and inserting “2023 through 2029”.
