

COMMITTEE ON NATURAL RESOURCES -- ACTION REPORT

The Committee on Natural Resources met in open session on Wednesday, February 11, 2026, to consider the following measures. [H.R. 5497 \(Rep. Tiffany\)](#), “*Apostle Islands National Park and Preserve Act*”

- Rep. Tom Tiffany (R-WI) offered an Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute designated Tiffany_039 ANS. The Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute **was agreed to by voice vote**.
- Ranking Member Jared Huffman (D-CA) offered an amendment to the Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute designated Huffman #1. The amendment **was not agreed to by a roll call vote of 16 yeas to 21 nays**.

H.R. 5497, as amended, was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by a **roll call vote of 20 yeas to 17 nays**.

[H.R. 6300 \(Rep. Hageman\)](#), “*Grasslands Grazing Act of 2025*”

The Subcommittee on Federal Lands was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 6300.

- Rep. Harriet Hageman (R-WY) offered an Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute designated Hageman_ANS. The Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute **was agreed to by voice vote**.
- Ranking Member Jared Huffman (D-CA) offered an amendment to the Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute designated Huffman #1 REVISED. The amendment **was not agreed to by a roll call vote of 16 yeas to 22 nays**.

H.R. 6300, as amended, was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by a **roll call vote of 25 yeas to 14 nays**.

[H.R. 755 \(Rep. Ciscomani\)](#), *“Critical Mineral Consistency Act of 2025”*

- Chairman Bruce Westerman (R-AR) offered an Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute designated Westerman_055 ANS. The Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute **was agreed to by unanimous consent.**

H.R. 755, as amended, was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by **unanimous consent.**

[H.R. 1352 \(Rep. Subramanyam\)](#), To designate the General George C. Marshall House, in the Commonwealth of Virginia, as an affiliated area of the National Park System, and for other purposes.

- Rep. Joe Neguse (D-CO) offered an amendment designated Neguse #1. The amendment **was agreed to by unanimous consent.**

H.R. 1352, as amended, was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by **unanimous consent.**

[H.R. 1945 \(Rep. Onder\)](#), *“America’s National Churchill Museum National Historic Landmark Act”*

The Subcommittee on Federal Lands was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 1945.

[H.R. 2196 \(Rep. Hudson\)](#), To provide for an extension of the legislative authority of the National Emergency Medical Services Memorial Foundation to establish a commemorative work in the District of Columbia and its environs.

The Subcommittee on Water, Wildlife and Fisheries was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 3706.
