

COMMITTEE ON NATURAL RESOURCES -- ACTION REPORT

The Committee on Natural Resources met in open session on Thursday, May 14, 2026, to consider the following measures. [H.R. 7487 \(Rep. Boebert\)](#), “*Rural Jobs and Hydropower Expansion Act*”

- Rep. Lauren Boebert (R-CO) offered an Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute designated Boebert_050 ANS. The Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute **was agreed to by voice vote**.
- Ranking Member Jared Huffman (D-CA) offered an amendment to the Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute designated Huffman #1. The amendment **was not agreed to by a roll call vote of 14 yeas to 21 nays**.

H.R. 7487, as amended, was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives **by a roll call vote of 21 yeas to 14 nays**.

[H.R. 741 \(Rep. Stanton\)](#), “*Stronger Engagement for Indian Health Needs Act of 2025*”

The Subcommittee on Indian and Insular Affairs was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 741.

- Ranking Member Jared Huffman (D-CA) offered an Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute designated Huffman_072 ANS. The Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute **was agreed to by unanimous consent**.

H.R. 741, as amended, was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives **by unanimous consent**.

[H.R. 3924 \(Rep. Neguse\)](#), “*Wildfire Risk Evaluation Act*”

The Subcommittee on Federal Lands was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 3924.

- Rep. Joe Neguse (D-CO) offered an Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute designated Neguse #1 ANS. The Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute **was agreed to by unanimous consent.**

H.R. 3924, as amended, was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by **unanimous consent.**

[H.R. 5694 \(Rep. Begich\)](#), “*Alaska’s Right To Ivory Sales and Tradition Act*” or the “*ARTIST Act*”

The Subcommittee on Water, Wildlife and Fisheries was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 5694.

- Rep. Nick Begich (R-AK) offered an Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute designated Begich_118 ANS. The Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute **was agreed to by unanimous consent.**

H.R. 5694, as amended, was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by **unanimous consent.**

[H.R. 7250 \(Rep. Downing\)](#), To reauthorize the Fort Peck Reservation Rural Water System Act of 2000.

The Subcommittee on Water, Wildlife and Fisheries was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 7250.

H.R. 7250 was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by **unanimous consent.**

[H.R. 7831 \(Rep. Kennedy of Utah\)](#), “*License to Drill Act*”
