

COMMITTEE ON NATURAL RESOURCES -- ACTION REPORT

The Committee on Natural Resources met in open session on Wednesday, July 22, 2026, to consider the following measures. H.R. 309 (Rep. Nehls), “*National Law Enforcement Officers Remembrance, Support and Community Outreach Act*”

The Subcommittee on Federal Lands was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 309.

- Chairman Bruce Westerman (R-AR) offered an Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute designated Westerman_086 ANS. The Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute was agreed to **by unanimous consent**.

H.R. 309, as amended, was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives **by unanimous consent**.

H.R. 1693 (Rep. Hageman), To redesignate the National Historic Trails Interpretive Center in Casper, Wyoming, as the “Barbara L. Cubin National Historic Trails Interpretive Center”.

The Subcommittee on Federal Lands was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 1693.

H.R. 1693 was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives **by unanimous consent**.

H.R. 4219 (Rep. Case), “*National Wildlife Refuge System Invasive Species Strike Team Act of 2025*”

The Subcommittee on Water, Wildlife, and Fisheries was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 4219.

- Ranking Member Jared Huffman (D-CA) offered an Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute designated Huffman_099 ANS. The Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute was agreed to **by unanimous consent**.

H.R. 4219, as amended, was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives **by unanimous consent**.

H.R. 4931 (Rep. Murphy of NC), “*National Park System Long-Term Lease Investment Act*”

The Subcommittee on Federal Lands was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 4931.

- Chairman Bruce Westerman (R-AR) offered an Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute designated Westerman_087 ANS. The Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute was agreed to **by unanimous consent**.

H.R. 4931, as amended, was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives **by unanimous consent**.

H.R. 5063 (Rep. Kiggans), “*Safe Beaches, Safe Swimmers Act*”

The Subcommittee on Federal Lands was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 5063.

- Rep. Jen Kiggans (R-VA) offered an Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute designated Kiggans_156 ANS. The Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute was agreed to **by unanimous consent**.

H.R. 5063, as amended, was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives **by unanimous consent**.

H.R. 6021 (Rep. Begich), “*Archie Cavanaugh Migratory Bird Treaty Amendment Act*”

The Subcommittee on Water, Wildlife, and Fisheries was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 6021.

- Rep. Nick Begich (R-AK) offered an Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute designated Begich_174 ANS. The Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute was agreed to **by unanimous consent**.

H.R. 6021, as amended, was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives **by unanimous consent**.

H.R. 8121 (Rep. Plaskett), To designate the Christiansted Bandstand at the Christiansted National Historic Site, St. Croix, Virgin Islands, as the “Peter G. Thurland, Sr., Bandstand”.

The Subcommittee on Federal Lands was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 8121.

- Rep. Joe Neguse (D-CO) offered an amendment designated Neguse #1. The amendment **was agreed to by unanimous consent.**

H.R. 8121, as amended, was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives **by unanimous consent.**

H.R. 8454 (Rep. McClintock), To provide for the transfer of administrative jurisdiction over certain Federal land in the State of California, and for other purposes.

The Subcommittee on Federal Lands was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 8454.

- Rep. Tom McClintock (R-CA) offered an Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute designated McClintock_092 ANS. The Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute was agreed to **by unanimous consent.**

H.R. 8454, as amended, was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives **by unanimous consent.**
