

COMMITTEE ON NATURAL RESOURCES -- ACTION REPORT

H.R. 1555 (Rep. Bice), “*Bureau of Land Management Mineral Spacing Act*”

The Subcommittee on Energy and Mineral Resources was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 1555.

- Ranking Member Jared Huffman (D-CA) offered an amendment to the Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute designated Huffman #1. The amendment was not agreed to **by a roll call vote of 16 yeas to 21 nays**.
- Chairman Bruce Westerman (R-AR) offered an Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute designated Westerman_01 ANS. The Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute was agreed to **by voice vote**.

H.R. 1555, as amended, was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives **by a roll call vote of 21 yeas to 16 nays**.

H.R. 5745 (Rep. Ezell), “*Marine Fisheries Habitat Protection Act*”

The Subcommittee on Energy and Mineral Resources was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 5745.

H.R. 5745, as amended, was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives **by a roll call vote of 22 yeas to 16 nays**.

H.R. 9621 (Rep. Baumgartner), “*Northwest Endangered Salmon Predation Prevention Act of 2026*”

The Subcommittee on Water, Wildlife and Fisheries was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 9621.

H.R. 181 (Rep. McClintock), To amend the Endangered Species Act of 1973 to provide that artificially propagated animals shall be treated the same under that Act as naturally propagated animals, and for other purposes.

- Rep. Adelita Grijalva (D-AZ) offered an amendment to the Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute designated Grijalva #1. The amendment was not agreed to **by a roll call vote of 18 yeas to 20 nays**.
- Chairman Bruce Westerman (R-AR) offered an Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute designated McClintock_072 ANS. The Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute was agreed to **by voice vote**.

H.R. 181, as amended, was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives **by a roll call vote of 21 yeas to 17 nays**.

H.R. 184 (Rep. McClintock), “*Action Versus No Action Act*”

The Subcommittee on Federal Lands was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 184.

- Rep. Tom McClintock (R-CA) offered an Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute designated McClintock ANS. The Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute was agreed to **by voice vote**.

H.R. 184, as amended, was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives **by a roll call vote of 21 yeas to 17 nays**.

H.R. 4598 (Rep. Leger Fernandez), “*Technical Corrections to the Northwestern New Mexico Rural Water Projects Act, Taos Pueblo Indian Water Rights Settlement Act, and Aamodt Litigation Settlement Act*”

H.R. 7254 (Rep. Huffman), To amend the National Trails System Act to direct the Secretary of the Interior to conduct a study on the feasibility of designating the Bay Area Ridge National Scenic Trail, and for other purposes.

The Subcommittee on Federal Lands was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 7254.

- Ranking Member Jared Huffman (D-CA) offered an amendment designated Huffman #1 REVISED. The amendment was agreed to **by unanimous consent**.

H.R. 7254, as amended, was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives **by unanimous consent**.

H.R. 7954 (Rep. Hurd), “Don Young Doug LaMalfa Indian Buffalo Management Act”

The Subcommittee on Indian and Insular Affairs was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 7954.

H.R. 7954 was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives **by unanimous consent.**

H.R. 8195 (Rep. Walberg), “Responsible Cormorant Management and Control Act of 2026”

The Subcommittee on Water, Wildlife and Fisheries was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 8195.

- Rep. Tim Walberg (R-MI) offered an Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute designated Walberg_042 ANS. The Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute was agreed to **by unanimous consent.**

H.R. 8195, as amended, was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives **by unanimous consent.**

H.R. 8483 (Rep. Issa), “Barona Group of Capitan Grande Band of Mission Indians Land Transfer Act of 2026”

The Subcommittee on Indian and Insular Affairs was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 8483.

H.R. 9269 (Rep. Clyburn), “Renewing the African American Civil Rights Network Act”
