- 3 SECTION 1. CRITICAL MATERIALS INCLUDED AS CRITICAL
- 4 MINERALS.
- 5 Section 7002 of the Energy Act of 2020 (30 U.S.C.
- 6 1606) is amended—
- 7 (1) in subsection (a)(3)(A), to read as follows:

1	"(A) IN GENERAL.—The term 'critical
2	mineral' means—
3	"(i) any mineral, element, substance,
4	or material designated as critical by the
5	Secretary under subsection (c); and
6	"(ii) a critical material as determined
7	by the Secretary of Energy under para-
8	graph (2)(A)."; and
9	(2) in subsection (e)(5), by adding at the end
10	the following:
11	"(C) INCLUSION OF CRITICAL MATE-
12	RIALS.—Not later than 45 days after the date
13	on which the Secretary of Energy determines a
14	non-fuel mineral, element, substance, or mate-
15	rial to be a critical material under subsection
16	(a)(2)(A), the Secretary shall update the list of
17	critical minerals published under paragraph (3)
18	to include such critical material.".
