Went to Cut Bank Boarding Dorm, Browning, MT from 1966 to 1970
Names of Matrons; Mr. Woodger; Mr. Lamb; Mr. Hodge; Bill Loring, He went from the 1st through the 4th grade.

1st abuse, cut hair and de-liced them. Dressed them in military clothes.
The matrons used their fists and thumped them on the head, calling them not-heads.
He was pulled off his bed with the sheets, off the top bunk, fell on the floor and broke his nose.
They twisted his ears, until they stood on their toes, then walked all the way down the hallway with them on their toes.
Placed them under a shelf with their heads, necks bent, for hours.
Kept them up at night on their knees scraping wax off the floor with razor blades all night until their knees were bleeding.
Stood them in a corner all night.
Couldn't learn in class because they were mentally and physically abused.

From David, who took Doug's oral testimony. "He can't hear very well, can't use a cell phone or answer messages. Can't read very well. Has a lot of lifelong disabilities from abuse at boarding school." David has known Doug nearly his whole life.
