Select Committee to Investigate the January 6th Attack on the United States Capitol

SELECT COMMITTEE ACTION

October 13, 2022

The Select Committee on the January 6th Attack on the United States Capitol met, pursuant to notice, in open session, a quorum being present, on Thursday, October 13, 2022, in 390 Cannon House Office Building, to consider a committee resolution.

Vice Chair CHENEY sent to the desk Committee Resolution 1, directing the Chairman to issue a subpoena to Donald J. Trump.

After debate, Chairman THOMPSON put the question viva voce and announced that the ayes had it.

Vice Chair CHENEY requested a recorded vote, and so a recorded vote was ordered.

The question was decided in the affirmative by a recorded vote of 9 ayes to 0 noes (Rollcall No. 5), so the committee resolution was agreed to.

By unanimous consent, the Select Committee adjourned at 3:32 p.m.
