AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A
SUBSTITUTE TO H.R. 549

OFFERED BY MR. COLLINS OF GA

At the end of the bill, add the following:

**1 SEC. 5. TEMPORARY PROTECTED STATUS
DESIGNATION.**

2 (a) CONGRESSIONAL REVIEW OF EXTENSION
OF

3 DESIGNATION.—Section 244(b)(3) of the
Immigration

4 and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1254a(b)(3)) is
amended—

5 (1) in subparagraph (A), by striking the final
6 sentence; and

7 (2) by striking subparagraph (C) and inserting
8 the following:

9 “(C) RECOMMENDATION TO CONGRESS TO

10 EXTEND DESIGNATION.—If the Secretary deter11
mines under subparagraph (A) that a foreign

12 state (or part of such foreign state) continues

13 to meet the condition for designation under

14 paragraph (1), the Secretary of Homeland Se15
curity shall submit a recommendation to the

16 Congress to extend the period of designation for

17 not more than 18 months. The Secretary shall

18 set forth the justification for the extension, including the humanitarian concerns, or how the extension otherwise is in the national interest.

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1 If, 90 days after the submission of the Secretary's recommendation, the President has not signed into law legislation passed by the House and the Senate extending the designation, the designation shall be terminated in accordance with subsection (d)(3).''.

PORARY PROTECTED STATUS.—Section 244(f)(4)
of the

9 Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1254(f)(4))
is

10 amended by striking the period at the end and
inserting

11 “but shall not be regarded as satisfying the definition
of

12 the term ‘admitted’ under section 101(a)(13)(A).’’.

13 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
14 this section shall take effect on the date of the
enactment

15 of this Act, except that the amendments made by
sub16

section (a) shall not apply to extensions pursuant to
sub17

section 244(b)(3)(C) of the Immigration and Nationality

18 Act (8 U.S.C. 1254a(b)(3)(C)) of designations
originally

19 made pursuant to section 244(b)(1) of such Act (8
U.S.C.

20 1254a(b)(1)) before such date.
