NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO H.R. 3884  
OFFERED BY MR. MCCLINTOCK OF CALIFORNIA**

Page 8, strike line 5 and all that follows through page 9, line 17 (and redesignate provisions accordingly).

Page 9, line 18, strike “**CREATION OF OPPORTUNITY TRUST FUND**” and insert “**CREATION OF LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUND**”.

Page 10, line 1, strike “**OPPORTUNITY TRUST FUND**” and insert “**LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUND**”.

Page 10, line 4, strike “Opportunity Trust Fund” and insert “Local Law Enforcement Trust Fund”.

Page 10, line 9, insert after “equivalent to” the following: “50 percent of”.

Page 10, strike line 12 and all that follows through page 11, line 2, and insert the following:

1       “(c) EXPENDITURES.—Amounts in the Trust Fund  
2 shall be available, without further appropriation, to the  
3 Attorney General to carry out section 3052(a) of part OO

1 of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of  
2 1968.”.

Page 11, strike lines 3 through 7, and insert the following:

3 (2) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sec-  
4 tions for subchapter A of chapter 98 of such Code  
5 is amended by adding at the end the following new  
6 item:

“Sec. 9512. Local Law Enforcement Trust Fund.”.

Page 15, strike line 1 and all that follows through  
page 28, line 13, and insert the following (and redesignate provisions accordingly):

7 **SEC. 6. LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUND PRO-**  
8 **GRAM.**

9 Title I of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe  
10 Streets Act of 1968 (34 U.S.C. et seq.) is amended by  
11 adding at the end the following:

12 **“PART OO—LAW ENFORCEMENT SUPPORT**  
13 **PROGRAM**

14 **“SEC. 3052. AUTHORIZATION.**

15 “The Attorney General shall establish and carry out  
16 a grant program, known as the ‘Law Enforcement Sup-  
17 port Program’, under which the Attorney General shall

1 award annual grants to each local law enforcement agency  
2 for law enforcement purposes.

3 **“SEC. 3053. FUNDING FROM LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT**  
4 **TRUST FUND.**

5 “(a) IN GENERAL.—The Attorney General shall  
6 carry out the program under this part using funds made  
7 available under section 9512(c) of the Internal Revenue  
8 Code.

9 “(b) DISTRIBUTION OF FUNDS.—A law enforcement  
10 agency that receives a grant under this part shall be allo-  
11 cated an amount that bears the same relationship as the  
12 population of the jurisdiction served by such agency bears  
13 to the total population of all jurisdictions served by law  
14 enforcement agencies.”.
