Dear Ambassador McKinley:

Pursuant to the House of Representatives' impeachment inquiry, we write to request your appearance at a voluntary transcribed interview on October 16, 2019, at 10:00 a.m. at The Capitol, HVC-304.

This interview will be conducted jointly by the Permanent Select Committee on Intelligence, the Committee on Foreign Affairs, and the Committee on Oversight and Reform. The interview transcript shall be part of the impeachment inquiry and shared among the Committees. You have the right to have personal counsel present at the interview.

The Committees are investigating the extent to which President Trump jeopardized national security by pressing Ukraine to interfere with our 2020 election and by withholding a White House meeting with the President of Ukraine and military assistance provided by Congress to help Ukraine counter Russian aggression, as well as any efforts to cover up these matters.

Based upon public reporting and evidence gathered as part of the impeachment inquiry, we believe you may have information relevant to specific matters under investigation.
