Mr. DESAULNIER introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

For the relief of Maria Isabel Bueso Barrera, Alberto Bueso Mendoza, Karla Maria Barrera De Bueso, and Ana Lucia Bueso Barrera.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENT STATUS FOR MARIA**
4 **ISABEL BUESO BARRERA, ALBERTO BUESO**
5 **MENDOZA, KARLA MARIA BARRERA DE**
6 **BUESO, AND ANA LUCIA BUESO BARRERA.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding subsections (a)
8 and (b) of section 201 of the Immigration and Nationality
9 Act, Maria Isabel Bueso Barrera, Alberto Bueso Mendoza,
10 Karla Maria Barrera De Bueso, and Ana Lucia Bueso

1 Barrera shall each be eligible for issuance of an immigrant
2 visa or for adjustment of status to that of an alien lawfully
3 admitted for permanent residence upon filing an applica-
4 tion for issuance of an immigrant visa under section 204
5 of such Act or for adjustment of status to lawful perma-
6 nent resident.

7 (b) ADJUSTMENT OF STATUS.—If Maria Isabel
8 Bueso Barrera, Alberto Bueso Mendoza, Karla Maria
9 Barrera De Bueso, or Ana Lucia Bueso Barrera enters
10 the United States before the filing deadline specified in
11 subsection (d), he or she shall be considered to have en-
12 tered and remained lawfully and shall, if otherwise eligible,
13 be eligible for adjustment of status under section 245 of
14 the Immigration and Nationality Act as of the date of the
15 enactment of this Act.

16 (c) WAIVER OF GROUNDS FOR REMOVAL OR DENIAL
17 OF ADMISSION.—

18 (1) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding sections
19 212(a) and 237(a) of the Immigration and Nation-
20 ality Act, Maria Isabel Bueso Barrera, Alberto
21 Bueso Mendoza, Karla Maria Barrera De Bueso,
22 and Ana Lucia Bueso Barrera may not be removed
23 from the United States, denied admission to the
24 United States, or considered ineligible for lawful per-
25 manent residence in the United States by reason of

1 any ground for removal or denial of admission that
2 is reflected in the records of the Department of
3 Homeland Security or the Visa Office of the Depart-
4 ment of State on the date of the enactment of this
5 Act.

6 (2) RESCISSION OF OUTSTANDING ORDER OF
7 REMOVAL.—The Secretary of Homeland Security
8 shall rescind any outstanding order of removal or de-
9 portation, or any finding of inadmissibility or de-
10 portability, that has been entered against Maria Isa-
11 bel Bueso Barrera, Alberto Bueso Mendoza, Karla
12 Maria Barrera De Bueso, or Ana Lucia Bueso
13 Barrera by reason of any ground described in para-
14 graph (1).

15 (d) DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION AND PAYMENT OF
16 FEES.—Subsections (a) and (b) shall apply only if the ap-
17 plication for issuance of an immigrant visa or the applica-
18 tion for adjustment of status is filed with appropriate fees
19 within 2 years after the date of the enactment of this Act.

20 (e) REDUCTION OF IMMIGRANT VISA NUMBER.—
21 Upon the granting of an immigrant visa or permanent res-
22 idence to Maria Isabel Bueso Barrera, Alberto Bueso
23 Mendoza, Karla Maria Barrera De Bueso, and Ana Lucia
24 Bueso Barrera, the Secretary of State shall instruct the
25 proper officer to reduce by 4, during the current or next

1 following fiscal year, the total number of immigrant visas
2 that are made available to natives of the country of the
3 aliens' birth under section 203(a) of the Immigration and
4 Nationality Act or, if applicable, the total number of immi-
5 grant visas that are made available to natives of the coun-
6 try of the aliens' birth under section 202(e) of such Act.

7 (f) DENIAL OF PREFERENTIAL IMMIGRATION TREAT-
8 MENT FOR CERTAIN RELATIVES.—The natural parents,
9 brothers, and sisters of Maria Isabel Bueso Barrera,
10 Alberto Bueso Mendoza, Karla Maria Barrera De Bueso,
11 and Ana Lucia Bueso Barrera shall not, by virtue of such
12 relationship, be accorded any right, privilege, or status
13 under the Immigration and Nationality Act.

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
