2nd Call uses our License to operate in the West Adams/ Arlington Heights Communities of Los Angeles, a portion of the Newton area of Los Angeles, the City of Inglewood and the city of Compton. We work in coordination with other gang intervention agencies and local law enforcement in creating dialogue with neighboring street gangs to mediate peace and understanding, along with safe passage, for all community members.



In March of 2006, Skipp Townsend and Kenneth Smith both of whom where once part of the destructive cycle of ignorance and violence in the community, decided to take a stand in rebuilding a safe and healthy community for all people. LIFE SKILLS & IMPACT SESSIONS

2nd Call has adapted a strategy to begin the healing process to uncover unresolved and vicarious trauma of the participants we work with. Our methods and techniques have been implemented in the California Institution for Women in Corona, CA since 2012. Our curriculum is based on planning for rupture and repair from the "Dysfunctional Family" issues. We instruct from a grassroots approach and empower with our highly trained team of 2nd Call facilitators.

We address topics such as:

- Low Self Esteem
- Functioning in Dysfunction
- Parenting and the cycle of violence
- Domestic Violence and Anger Management
- Unresolved and Vicarious Trauma
- Effective Communication
- Job Readiness and Retention

2nd Call works directly with local unions and other construction companies in assisting the participants that have completed 2nd Call's "job readiness & job retention" course. We assist all individuals with life skills and gainful employment based on their own determination and commitment for success. 2nd Call also assists, in referring participants to transitional housing and sober living homes. We work directly with volunteer tutors & the L.A.C.O.E. Schools in assisting young adults in continuing the educational process.



2nd Call holds weekly classes inside prison walls helping the general inmate population with, reentry, anger and other basic life skills needed for a healthy return to society.
