SUMMARY

Beginning in 2015 with the election of Kim Foxx, first of the George Soros-promoted rogue prosecutors, as Cook County (Chicago) State’s Attorney, cities with rogue prosecutors have imposed policies that all—each and every one of them—inure to the benefit of criminals.
