Truth in Testimony Disclosure



In July 2013, ALPA was awarded an "Other Transaction Agreement (OTA)" to perform services in support of the Human Intervention and Motivation Study (HIMS) VII. (Requisition WA-13-07261). This OTA was requisitioned by the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA), Office of Aerospace Medicine. The contract became effective 7/27/13 and was effective for one year to 7/26/14. \$200,000.00 is the amount of the contract. The FAA subsequently modified the OTA (Modification No. 0001) extending the period of performance for an additional three months thru October 31, 2014, and increasing the contract amount by an additional \$125,000.00. ALPA was awarded a new contract (DTFAWA-14-A-80002) that began on November 1, 2014 and is currently performing services under this contract. The contract is for \$315,000.00 for the first year and has two additional "option" years with the same budget.

With respect to the two earlier fiscal years, ALPA was performing work under Requisition No. WA-10-03230, a Contract with the FAA, Office of Aerospace Medicine in support of the HIMS program. ALPA completed performance for the base year (2010-11) and was awarded two additional one-year options (7/27/11 – 7/26/12 and 7/27/12 – 7/26/13). \$200,000.00 was the amount per year.
