Amendment to H.R. 1987 Offered by Ms. Hahn of California

At the end of title V add the following:

1 SEC. 5____. MERCHANT MARINER EQUITY COMPENSATION 2 FUND.

3 (a) COMPENSATION FUND.—(1) There is in the gen4 eral fund of the Treasury a fund to be known as the "Mer5 chant Mariner Equity Compensation Fund" (in this sec6 tion referred to as the "compensation fund").

7 (2) Subject to the availability of appropriations for 8 such purpose, amounts in the compensation fund shall be 9 available to the Secretary of the department in which the 10 Coast Guard is operating without fiscal year limitation to 11 make payments to eligible individuals in accordance with 12 this section.

13 (b) ELIGIBLE INDIVIDUALS.—(1) An eligible indi-14 vidual is an individual who—

(A) during the one-year period beginning on the
date of the enactment of this section, submits to the
Secretary an application containing such information
and assurances as the Secretary may require;

1	(B) has not received benefits under the Service-
2	men's Readjustment Act of 1944 (Public Law 78–
3	346); and
4	(C) has engaged in qualified service.
5	(2) For purposes of paragraph (1), a person has en-
6	gaged in qualified service if, between December 7, 1941,
7	and December 31, 1946, the person—
8	(A) was a member of the United States mer-
9	chant marine (including the Army Transport Service
10	and the Naval Transport Service) serving as a crew-
11	member of a vessel that was—
12	(i) operated by the War Shipping Adminis-
13	tration or the Office of Defense Transportation
14	(or an agent of the Administration or Office);
15	(ii) operated in waters other than inland
16	waters, the Great Lakes, and other lakes, bays,
17	and harbors of the United States;
18	(iii) under contract or charter to, or prop-
19	erty of, the Government of the United States;
20	and
21	(iv) serving the Armed Forces; and
22	(B) while so serving, was licensed or otherwise
23	documented for service as a crewmember of such a
24	vessel by an officer or employee of the United States

authorized to license or document the person for
 such service.

3 (3) In determining the information and assurances
4 required in the application pursuant to paragraph (1)(A),
5 the Secretary shall accept a DD-214 form as proof of
6 qualified service.

7 (c) AMOUNT OF PAYMENT.—The Secretary shall 8 make one payment out of the compensation fund in the 9 amount of \$25,000 to an eligible individual. The Secretary 10 shall make such a payment to eligible individuals in the 11 order in which the Secretary receives the applications of 12 the eligible individuals.

(d) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—In addi14 tion to the other amounts authorized by this Act, there
15 is authorized to be appropriated for fiscal year 2016
16 \$125,000,000 for the compensation fund. Such amount
17 shall remain available until expended.

18 (e) REPORTS.—The Secretary shall include, in documents submitted to Congress by the Secretary in support 19 of the President's budget for each fiscal year, detailed in-20 21 formation on the operation of the compensation fund, in-22 cluding the number of applicants, the number of eligible 23 individuals receiving benefits, the amounts paid out of the 24 compensation fund, the administration of the compensa-25 tion fund, and an estimate of the amounts necessary to

fully fund the compensation fund for that fiscal year and
 each of the three subsequent fiscal years.

3 (f) REGULATIONS.—Not later than 180 days after
4 the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary shall
5 prescribe regulations to carry out this section.
