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## A BILL

To amend title 40, United States Code, to require the Administrator of General Services to enter into a cooperative agreement with the National Children’s Museum to provide the National Children’s Museum rental space without charge in the Ronald Reagan Building and International Trade Center, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “National Children’s  
5 Museum Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. NATIONAL CHILDREN'S MUSEUM.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 67 of title 40, United  
3 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-  
4 lowing:

5 **“§ 6735. National Children’s Museum**

6 “(a) IN GENERAL.— Not later than 1 month after  
7 the date of enactment of this section, the Administrator  
8 of General Services shall enter into a cooperative agree-  
9 ment with the National Children’s Museum for the oper-  
10 ation of the National Children’s Museum in the space de-  
11 scribed under subsection (c) of the Ronald Reagan Build-  
12 ing and International Trade Center.

13 “(b) CONTENTS.—The cooperative agreement under  
14 subsection (a) shall include provisions that—

15 “(1) make the space described under subsection  
16 (c) available to the National Children’s Museum in  
17 perpetuity without charge;

18 “(2) require the General Services Administra-  
19 tion to provide, subject to available appropriations,  
20 such maintenance (including maintenance of the  
21 structural portions of the space described in sub-  
22 section (c) and any HVAC, electrical, gas, steam,  
23 sprinkler, and mechanical facilities or systems), se-  
24 curity, information, janitorial, and other services as  
25 may be necessary to ensure the preservation and op-  
26 eration of the site; and

1           “(3) provide a right of first refusal to the Na-  
2           tional Children’s Museum for any adjacent rental  
3           space in the Ronald Reagan Building and Inter-  
4           national Trade Center for an agreed upon rate.

5           “(c) MUSEUM SPACE.—The cooperative agreement  
6           under subsection (a) shall designate the pavilion and the  
7           occupiable space on the floor adjacent to the pavilion of  
8           the Ronald Reagan Building and International Trade Cen-  
9           ter as the space for the National Children’s Museum.”.

10          (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The analysis for chap-  
11          ter 67 of title 40, United States Code, is amended by add-  
12          ing at the end the following:

“6735. National Children’s Museum.”.

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
