

**AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDMENT IN THE
NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO H.R. 3935
OFFERED BY MS. HOYLE OF OREGON**

Page 469, after line 15, insert the following:

1 (d) TRAINING MATERIALS.—

2 (1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 1 year after
3 the date of enactment of this section, the Adminis-
4 trator shall develop and publish training and related
5 educational materials about aircraft engine ingestion
6 and jet blast hazards for ground crews (including
7 supervisory employees) that includes information
8 on—

9 (A) the specific dangers and consequences
10 of entering engine ingestion or jet blast zones;

11 (B) proper protocols to avoid entering an
12 engine ingestion or jet blast zone; and

13 (C) on-the-job, instructor-led training to
14 physically demonstrate the engine ingestion
15 zone boundaries and jet blast zones for each
16 kind of aircraft the ground crew may encounter.

17 (2) TRAINING REGULATIONS.—Not later than
18 180 days after the publication of the training and
19 related educational materials described in paragraph

1 (1), the Administrator shall promulgate regulations
2 to require any new, transferred, or current (as of the
3 date of enactment of this section) employee of the
4 Federal Aviation Administration to receive the rel-
5 evant engine ingestion and jet blast zone hazard
6 training before such employee may perform work on
7 the apron.
