As North Carolina Department of Transportation's Deputy Secretary for Multi-Modal Transportation, Ms. White oversees the operations of the Rail Division, the Division of Aviation, the Ferry Division, and the Integrated Mobility Division which includes Public Transportation, Bicycle and Pedestrian Transportation. She chairs the Southeast Corridor Commission, helping to lead efforts and build momentum to develop a high-performance rail system in the Southeast. She serves on the Board of Directors of the American Public Transportation Association.

Ms. White has spent over two decades in state and local government having served as executive director of the North Carolina Metropolitan Mayors Coalition before coming to NCDOT.
