RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the Senate amendments to the House amendment to the bill (S. 2938) to designate the United States Courthouse and Federal Building located at 111 North Adams Street in Tallahassee, Florida, as the "Joseph Woodrow Hatchett United States Courthouse and Federal Building", and for other purposes; providing for consideration of the Senate amend-

ment to the House amendment to the bill (S. 2089) to amend the Families First Coronavirus Response Act to extend child nutrition waiver authority, and for other purposes; relating to consideration of the Senate amendment to the bill (H.R. 4346) making appropriations for Legislative Branch for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2022, and for other purposes; and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it
2 shall be in order to take from the Speaker's table the bill
3 (S. 2938) to designate the United States Courthouse and
4 Federal Building located at 111 North Adams Street in
5 Tallahassee, Florida, as the "Joseph Woodrow Hatchett
6 United States Courthouse and Federal Building", and for
7 other purposes, with the Senate amendments to the House
8 amendment thereto, and to consider in the House, without
9 intervention of any point of order, a single motion offered
10 by the chair of the Committee on the Judiciary or his des-
11 ignee that the House concur in the Senate amendments
12 to the House amendment. The Senate amendments and
13 the motion shall be considered as read. The motion shall
14 be debatable for one hour equally divided and controlled
15 by the chair and ranking minority member of the Com-
16 mittee on the Judiciary or their respective designees. The
17 previous question shall be considered as ordered on the
18 motion to its adoption without intervening motion or de-
19 mand for division of the question.

1 SEC. 2. Upon adoption of this resolution it shall be
2 in order to take from the Speaker's table the bill (S. 2089)
3 to amend the Families First Coronavirus Response Act
4 to extend child nutrition waiver authority, and for other
5 purposes, with the Senate amendment to the House
6 amendment thereto, and to consider in the House, without
7 intervention of any point of order, a motion offered by the
8 chair of the Committee on Education and Labor or his
9 designee that the House concur in the Senate amendment
10 to the House amendment. The Senate amendment and the
11 motion shall be considered as read. The motion shall be
12 debatable for 10 minutes equally divided and controlled
13 by the chair and ranking minority member of the Com-
14 mittee on Education and Labor or their respective des-
15 ignees. The previous question shall be considered as or-
16 dered on the motion to its adoption without intervening
17 motion.

18 SEC. 3. Upon adoption of this resolution, the House
19 shall be considered to have taken from the Speaker's table
20 the bill (H.R. 4346) making appropriations for Legislative
21 Branch for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2022,
22 and for other purposes, with the Senate amendment there-
23 to, and to have concurred in the Senate amendment with
24 an amendment consisting of the text of Rules Committee
25 Print 117-53.
