The Committee on Small Business will hold a markup of legislation to amend the following measures. The markup will be held at **9:45 A.M. ET on Thursday, September 14, 2023**, in room 2360 of the Rayburn House Office Building. The items that will be marked up include:

- **H ____**: A bill to amend the Small Business Economic Policy Act of 1980 to examine how the competitiveness of small businesses is affected by the enforcement of Federal antitrust laws, and for other purposes.
- **H ____**: A bill to amend the Small Business Act to require a report on the performance of the Office of Rural Affairs, to require a report on the memorandum of understanding between the Small Business Administration and the Department of Agriculture entered into on April 4, 2018, and for other purposes.
- **H ____**: A bill to amend the Small Business Act to enhance the Office of Rural Affairs, and for other purposes.
- **H ____**: A bill to require the Administrator of the Small Business Administration to provide a link to resources for submitting reports on suspected fraud relating to certain COVID-19 loans.
- **H ____**: A bill to prohibit individuals convicted of defrauding the Government from receiving any assistance from the Small Business Administration, and for other purposes.

** Additional legislation may be added for consideration*

Any Member wishing to submit an amendment for consideration must provide the Committee with a written form no later than 24-hours prior to the markup to the attention of Emma Ver Hage, Committee Clerk (emma.verhage@mail.house.gov).

Members are encouraged to work with Legislative Counsel and Committee staff in drafting their amendments. While Members may file amendments, in writing, at any time prior to or during the markup, the Chair prefers that amendments be prefiled. This will enable all Members to have sufficient time to review the amendments. Please be aware that:

- Amendments filed 24-hours prior to the markup will be given priority consideration at the markup.
- The Chairman may refuse a unanimous consent request to consider the amendment as read if it is not filed and in compliance to the 24-hour prior deadline.
- Amendments filed after the deadline may not be distributed to Members until the start of the markup.
- Amendments drafted and offered after the commencement of the markup may necessitate the Chair recessing the markup to enable Committee staff to copy and distribute such amendments.
- All amendments must be in writing.
