The Committee on Science, Space, and Technology will meet on **Wednesday, September 21, 2016, at 1:00 p.m.** in Room 2318 of the Rayburn House Office Building to consider the following:

**H.R. \_\_\_\_\_, the “To Research, Evaluate, Assess, and Treat Astronauts Act” (TREAT Astronauts Act).**

**H.R. \_\_\_\_\_, the “Cybersecurity Responsibility and Accountability Act of 2016.”**

**H.R. 5829, the “ADVISE Now Act.”**

**H.R. \_\_\_\_\_, the “TREAT Astronauts Act,”** will be introduced by Space Subcommittee Chairman Brian Babin on September 20, 2016. The bill requires the Administrator of the National Aeronautics and Space Administration to establish a program for the medical monitoring, diagnosis, and treatment of astronauts, and for other purposes.

**H.R. \_\_\_\_\_, the “Cybersecurity Responsibility and Accountability Act of 2016,”** will be introduced by Representative Ralph Abraham on September 19, 2016. The bill enhances Federal cybersecurity research and accountability.

**H.R. 5829, the “ADVISE Now Act,”** was introduced by Representative Rodney Davis on July 14, 2016. The bill provides for the prompt establishment by the Science Advisory Board of the Environmental Protection Agency of an agriculture committee.
