# H. R. 4451

To amend title 38, United States Code, to provide for a five-year extension to the homeless veterans reintegration programs and to provide clarification regarding eligibility for services under such programs.

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## A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to provide for a five-year extension to the homeless veterans reintegration programs and to provide clarification regarding eligibility for services under such programs.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Homeless Veterans’  
5 Reintegration Programs Reauthorization Act of 2018”.

1 **SEC. 2. REAUTHORIZATION OF HOMELESS VETERANS RE-**  
2 **INTEGRATION PROGRAMS.**

3 (a) FIVE-YEAR EXTENSION OF HOMELESS VET-  
4 ERANS REINTEGRATION PROGRAMS.—Section 2021(e)(F)  
5 of title 38, United States Code, is amended by striking  
6 “2017” and inserting “2022”.

7 (b) FIVE-YEAR EXTENSION OF HOMELESS WOMEN  
8 VETERANS AND HOMELESS VETERANS WITH CHILDREN  
9 REINTEGRATION GRANT PROGRAM.—Section 2021A(f)(1)  
10 of such title is amended by striking “2017” and inserting  
11 “2022”.

12 (c) CLARIFICATION OF ELIGIBILITY FOR SERVICES  
13 UNDER HOMELESS VETERANS REINTEGRATION PRO-  
14 GRAMS.—Section 2021(a) of such title is amended by  
15 striking “reintegration of homeless veterans into the labor  
16 force.” and inserting the following: “reintegration into the  
17 labor force of—

18 “(1) homeless veterans (including veterans who  
19 were homeless but found housing during the 60-day  
20 period preceding the date on which the veteran be-  
21 gins to participate in a program under this section);

22 “(2) veterans participating in the Department  
23 of Veterans Affairs supported housing program for  
24 which rental assistance is provided pursuant to sec-  
25 tion 8(o)(19) of the United States Housing Act of  
26 1937 (42 U.S.C. 1437f(o)(19)) or the Tribal HUD—

1 VA Supportive Housing (Tribal HUD–VASH) pro-  
2 gram;

3 “(3) Indians who are veterans and receiving as-  
4 sistance under the Native American Housing Assist-  
5 ance and Self Determination Act of 1996 (25 U.S.C.  
6 4101 et seq.);

7 “(4) veterans described in section 2023(e) of  
8 this title or any other veterans who are transitioning  
9 from being incarcerated; and

10 “(5) veterans participating in the Department  
11 of Veterans Affairs rapid rehousing and prevention  
12 program authorized in section 2044 of this title.”.
