## A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to establish qualifications for the appointment of a person as a marriage and family therapist, qualified to provide clinical supervision, in the Veterans Health Administration.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. ESTABLISHMENT OF QUALIFICATIONS FOR**  
2 **THE APPOINTMENT OF A PERSON AS A MAR-**  
3 **RIAGE AND FAMILY THERAPIST, QUALIFIED**  
4 **TO PROVIDE CLINICAL SUPERVISION, IN THE**  
5 **VETERANS HEALTH ADMINISTRATION.**

6 Section 7402(b)(10) of title 38, United States Code,  
7 is amended—

8 (1) by redesignating subparagraphs (A) and  
9 (B) as clauses (i) and (ii), respectively;

10 (2) by inserting “(A)” before “To be eligible”;  
11 and

12 (3) by adding at the end the following new sub-  
13 paragraph (B):

14 “(B) To be eligible to be appointed to a marriage and  
15 family therapist position and qualified to provide clinical  
16 supervision, a person must—

17 “(i) have the qualifications set forth in subpara-  
18 graph (A); and

19 “(ii)(I) be authorized to provide clinical super-  
20 vision in the State described in clause (ii) of such  
21 subparagraph; or

22 “(II) be designated as an approved supervisor  
23 by the American Association for Marriage and Fam-  
24 ily Therapy.”.
