

Dr. Marsden McGuire currently serves as Director, Continuum of Care and General Mental Health in the Office of Mental Health and Suicide Prevention at the Department of Veterans Affairs, Washington, DC. His primary responsibility is oversight of national policy across the full continuum of mental health care including inpatient and outpatient mental health, residential care, evidence-based psychotherapies, somatic treatments, psychosocial recovery and rehabilitation services, substance-use disorders, geriatric mental health, women's mental health and family services. He has led numerous efforts within VA, and with other federal agencies, to promote Veteran-centered care that is safe, effective and measurable.
