The vote on the amendment offered by Ms. Chu to the amendment in the nature of a substitute offered by Chairman Brady to H.R. 6306, which would allow individuals with Health Savings Accounts (HSAs) to temporarily designate immigrant children in detention settings or unaccompanied children in the custody of the Office of Refugee Resettlement (ORR) as dependents for purposes of using HSA funds for their medical care, was not agreed to by a roll call vote of 16 yeas to 22 nays.
