

**An Incomplete List of Protestors Who Were Either Arrested or Released on Bail  
Pending Trial in the Fall 2022  
(Attached to Tong Yi's written Testimony)**

**Beijing**

1. Li Siqi (李思琪) Female, 27 years old, journalist and freelance writer. Earned a master's degree from Goldsmith College, University of London. On 11/28/2022, she was summoned by the police. On 12/20/2022, she was detained on charges of "gathering crowds to disturb public order." On 1/19/2023, she was arrested for "picking quarrels and provoking trouble."
2. Li Yuanjing (李元婧) Female, born on 12/22/1995, accountant working for PricewaterhouseCoopers, Beijing. Earned a master's degree from New South Wales University of Australia. On 11/28/2022, she was summoned by the police. On 12/20/22, she was detained on charges of "gathering crowds to disturb public order." On 1/19/23, she was arrested for "picking quarrels and provoking trouble."
3. Zhai Dengrui (翟登蕊) Female, 27 years old, teacher. Earned a master's degree in world literature from Beijing Foreign Studies University. The same experience as No.1.
4. Cao Zhixin (曹止馨) Female, 27 years old, an editor at Peking University Press. Earned a master's degree in history from Renmin University. Similar experience as No. 1, except was caught in Hunan and brought to Beijing around 12/23/2022. She asked a friend to release a short video on YouTube about what her friends in the same Telegram group did and insisted on their innocence before she was detained in late December.
5. Cao Yuan (曹原) Female. Earned a master's degree from Renmin University. 1/6/2023 was caught in Shanghai by Beijing police. Currently under arrest.
6. Xin Shang (辛賞) Male. Studied documentary filming at University of Westminster for a year. On 11/27/2022, at the Liangmaqiao demonstration, read an excerpt from a Shakespeare Sonnet to the police. On 1/7/2023, he was arrested. His parents received notice of an arrest for "endangering public security."
7. Zhai Chunming (翟春明) Male. Graduated from Tianjin University of Traditional Chinese Medicine. Medical representative for AstraZeneca. On 1/8/2023 was detained for "picking quarrels and provoking trouble." Was released on bail pending trial around 2/10/2023.
8. Sun Yingqi (孫穎琦) Female. Girlfriend of Zhai Chunming. Similar experience as No. 7.

9. Yang Liu (楊柳) Female, 27 years old. Journalist for The Beijing News. Earned a master's degree from a Singapore university. Similar experience as No. 1, except that she was released on bail pending trial on 1/19/2023.
10. Lin Yun (林昀) Male. Boyfriend of No. 9, about 30 years old. Owner of Buer Bistro, musician. Similar experience as No. 9.
11. Qin Ziyi (秦梓奕) Female. Former journalist for Caixin Media; later freelance writer. Earned a master's degree in Sociology from University of Chicago in 2017. Similar experience as No. 9.
12. Jia Xinxu (賈新栩) Male, 57 years old. Poet and writer. Pen name is "Gouzi" ("the dog"). Was released on bail pending trial around 1/19/2023.
13. Lin Qian (林倩) Female. Translator. Did not go to protest but was detained together with No. 2. Was released on bail pending trial on 1/19/2023.
14. Gao Xiangning (高香凝) Female. Was released on bail pending trial on 1/19/2023.
15. Chen Junhui (陳軍輝) Male. Artist. Was released on bail pending trial on 1/19/2023.
16. Li Feifei (李飛飛) Working in the field of digital marketing. Was detained on 12/22/2022.
17. Bai Er (白洱) Owner of a bar. Was detained on 1/4/2023.
18. Kong Che (孔澈) A DJ and a teacher. Was detained on 1/6/2023
19. Yao Yao (搖搖, nickname) DJ. Was detained on 1/6/2023
20. Xiao Shan (小山, nickname) Was detained on 1/6/2023
21. Chaoran/Cathy (超然) Female, financial professional. Disappeared.
22. Sister Wang (王姐) Female, DJ, commercial airline worker. Was detained on 1/6/2023.
23. Little Mei (小梅) Female. Was detained on 1/6/2023.
24. XFZ (the person's name on social media) Was detained on 1/6/2023.
25. Wang Xue (王雪) Female, journalist. Was detained on 1/14/2023.
26. Ni Ni (泥泥 nickname) Fashion editor. Was detained on 1/16/2023.

27. A Er (阿爾, nickname) Product operation professional. Was roommate with No. 26. Was detained together with No. 26 on 1/16/2023.
28. Guo Yi/Edith (郭藝) Female. Graduated from Tsing-hua University. After Peng Lifa unfurled the slogans at Sitong Bridge, she spread around the same slogans in public lavatories in Beijing. She was detained in late October 2022, and was released on parole pending trial around 02/19/2023.
29. Hou Jinyi (侯金藝) Female, an auditor for KPMG. Studied overseas. Calling colleagues to attend Liangmaqiao demonstration. Was taken away by the police from her working place on 11/28/2022 but later was let go. However, on 1/24/2023, she was detained in Zhengzhou with no more information.

### **Guangzhou**

1. Yang Zijing/Cookies (楊紫荊/點心) Female, 26 years old. Graduated from Harbin Engineering University. On 11/27/2022, attended the demonstration at Haizhu Square in Guangzhou. Was detained in early December 2022. Was released on bail pending trial on 1/3/2023.
2. Chen Dali (陳大栗) Male, 30 years old, NGO worker. Same experience as No. 1.
3. Wang Xiaoyu (王曉宇) Male, 30 years old, NGO worker. Same experience as No. 2.

### **Shanghai (with scant information)**

1. Xia Chaochuan (夏巢川) Tweeted that Shanghai Tianlin New Village police (田林新村派出所) had tortured “White Paper” participants. His twitter account stopped being updated on 12/5/2022.
2. Li Yi (李藝) Was detained on 11/29/2022 for “picking quarrels and provoking trouble.”
3. Flower Boy (鮮花男孩) We don’t know this brave man’s name. He protested while raising a bouquet of yellow flowers at Urumqi Zhong Road in Shanghai, and publicly calling for freedom of assembly in front of the police and other protesters. He was videoed when the police took him away.
4. Chen Jialin (陳佳林) Male. Born on 9/25/1997. Protested at Urumqi Zhong Road in Shanghai and interviewed with Radio Free Asia. Was taken away to Shanghai No. 2 Detention Center on 11/29/2022.
5. Qin Chao (秦超) Was from Liu-an (六安) , Anhui Province. At around 10 pm on 11/27/2022, was taken away by the police.

### **Chengdu (with scant information)**

1. Fat Tiger (nickname, 胖虎) Female, tattoo artist. Was detained in early December 2022. Was released on bail pending trial on 12/23/2022.
2. Huang Hao (黃顥) Male, 27 years old, apprentice lawyer. Same experience as No. 1.
3. Xia Nan (夏南, pseudonym) Uyghur. Was detained around 11/28/2022. Was released on bail pending trial on 12/17/2022.
4. Zamkar (贊嘎, Tibetan) Female, 26 years old. On 12/2/2022, attended the “White Paper” demonstration in Chengdu. Disappeared on 12/5/2022.
5. Kelsang Dolma (格桑卓瑪, Tibetan) Female, 28 years old. Same experience as No. 4.
6. Dechen (德成, Tibetan) Female. Same experience as No. 4.
7. Delta (德拉, Tibetan) Female. Same experience as No. 4.

## **Nanjing**

1. Li Kangmeng (李康夢) Female, student at Communication University of China, Nanjing. She was considered the first person to have held up a white paper to protest on 11/26/2022. She has since disappeared.
2. Siyuan Zhuyi (司原逐藝) Male, artist. He disappeared in October 2022. His paintings showcase the pain and suffering of ordinary people under the zero Covid policy.

## **Others**

1. Kamile Wayit (卡米萊 瓦伊特) Female, Uyghur, 19-year-old student at a university in Henan Province. She was “disappeared” after she returned to Xinjiang during the winter break in December. Her family suspects that she was detained for passing to her friends information about “White Paper” protests in various cities.
